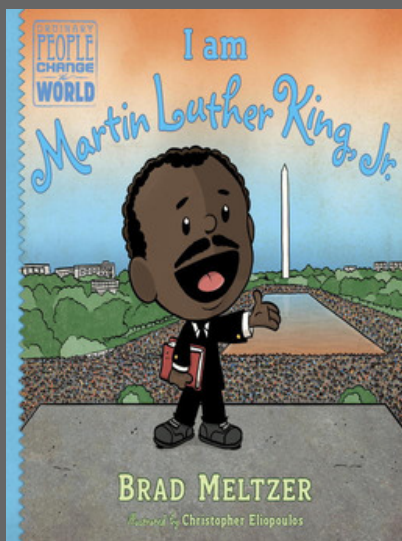

We can all be heroes. A great introduction to Martin Luther King, Jr.'s life and legacy.

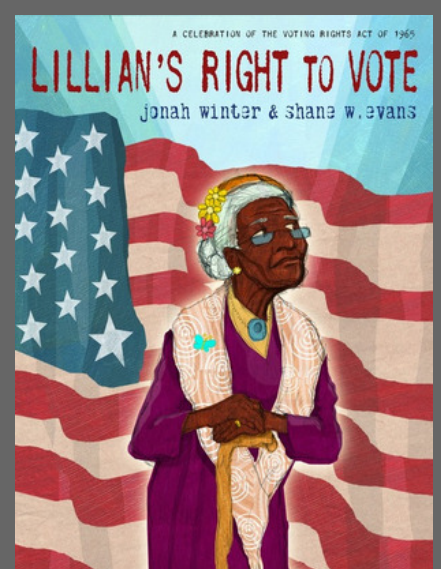

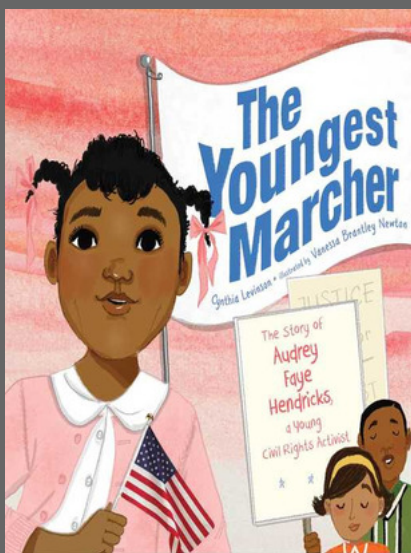


The Youngest Marcher

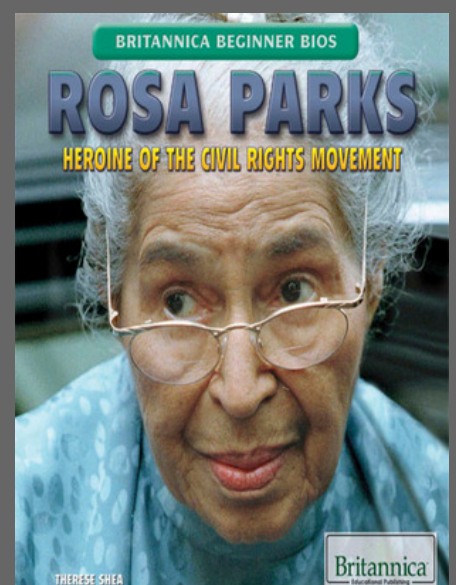


Rosa Parks
